APGO Education Foundation announces inaugural recipient of new professional ethics exam bursary

July 20, 2022, Toronto, Ontario: The APGO Education Foundation ("the Foundation or APGOEF") is pleased to announce the recipient of its new established Professional Ethics Exam (PPE) Bursary. This new Bursary Program provides funding support of \$1,500 to recent immigrants who are Geoscientists-in Training (GIT's) or provisionally accepted Professional Geoscientists (P.Geo.s) with Professional Geoscientists Ontario (PGO) to complete their Professional Practice and Ethics (PPE) Exam required for registration. This program has been developed in partnership with The Professional Access Into Employment (PAIE) program operated by the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority. The bursary recipient was chosen by a Selection Committee formed by the Board of Directors of the Foundation.

Inaugural Professional Ethics Exam Bursary Recipient:

Ms. Rita Nzeribe

Ms. Nzeribe immigrated to Canada with a background in geoscience and a major in geophysics. She has worked in the oil and gas industry and presently is seeking to transition to the environmental area of practice in which most organizations in Canada require a licensed candidate. She currently has a provisional professional license with PGO and plans to complete the PPE exam to become fully registered.

Dr. Bill Pearson, P.Geo., Chair of the Foundation, commented "We are delighted to award our inaugural PPE Bursary which we hope will be one of many more to come. It is very important that our profession supports internationally trained geoscientists to obtain their registration as professional geoscientists. This program augments our existing full bursary program (\$5,000) to cover applicants who need only to complete the PPE Exam to obtain their full registration. We are very pleased to partner with the PAIE program to implement this new bursary."
