The Foundation scholarships are \$5,000 each. The scholarship recipients were chosen by a Selection Committee appointed by the Board of Directors of the Foundation and received the scholarships at the Foundation's Board meeting on September 14, 2023.

We look forward to continuing to support up and coming geoscientists through our scholarship program. Since its inception in 2016, we have awarded 15 scholarships totaling \$75,000."
