



**UP TO \$10,000 BURSARY PROGRAM FOR
INTERNATIONALLY TRAINED GEOSCIENTISTS
APPLICATIONS OPEN**

APRIL 17, 2017 Toronto, Ontario: The APGO Education Foundation (“the Foundation”) is pleased to announce the opening of applications for its **Bursary Program** that supports immigrants to Canada who are internationally-trained geoscientists and have demonstrated financial need for completion of licensure procedures for registration as a professional geoscientist (P.Geo.) in Ontario. **Two bursaries**, the **Arsalan Mohajer Bursary** and the **Past Presidents’ Bursary**, of **up to \$5,000 each** will be awarded. The Foundation will be working closely with the Registrar of the Association of Professional Geoscientists of Ontario (APGO) to identify potential candidates. The application process is open to all who think they may be eligible. The bursary recipients will be determined by a Selection Committee formed by the Board of Directors of the Foundation and will receive the bursaries at the Annual Meeting of APGO to be held on June 8th in Toronto.

Dr. Bill Pearson, P.Geo., Chair of the Foundation, commented: “We are very pleased to offer the bursary program. It is very important that we assist recent immigrants who are geoscience-trained to obtain their professional registration with APGO to enable them to practice as professionals in Ontario. We are also working with APGO to enhance mentoring of these Individuals as they further develop their professional careers.”
