August 17, 2022, Toronto, Ontario: The APGO Education Foundation ("The Foundation or APGOEF") is pleased to announce the release of its annual report for 2022 which is available on <u>our website</u>. Highlights are as follows:

- **Donations** of \$253,576 received in 2022
- First series of GeoTrails on the Bruce Trail released in partnership with McMaster University and the Bruce Trail Conservancy in the Hamilton and Niagara Region.
- First ever Urban GeoTrail developed in partnership with the University of Toronto on the downtown campus.
- Launched a new blog called Beneath Your Feet: A Geoscience Blog with 31 articles published in 2022.
- **Displayed "Rocks of the Kingston Area"** at the annual Kingston Science Rendevous with partner Mining Matters and were voted "Best Booth in Show" by the attendees.
- Exhibited at the Bancroft Rockhound Gemboree with hands-on activities for kids; more than 1,000 people visited our booth.
- **Showcased our developing GeoTrails** at the Ottawa Lapsmith and Mineral Club Mineral Show generating strong interest for Geotrails on the Rideau Trail.
- As the Geoscience Education Partner for the Niagara Peninsula Aspiring Global Geopark, developed the first GeoTrails in the proposed Geopark at Ball's Falls and Cave Springs and supported their application process to be recognized as a UNESCO Global Geopark.

Dr. Bill Pearson, P.Geo., Chair commented: "2022 was a very productive year as we were able to carry out a full summer's field program to significantly expand our GeoTrails along the Bruce Trail and in the proposed Geopark in the Niagara Peninsula. Many thanks to our generous donors and to our dedicated team - Dr. Deana Schwarz, P.Geo., Manager GeoscienceINFO.com, Bernard Kradjian, Communications Manager, Veronica Klassen, Manager of our Blog and Monique Gaudet, Business Manager, for their excellent work over the past year.
