

APGO EDUCATION FOUNDATION AWARDS TWO SCHOLARSHIPS TO GEOSCIENCE STUDENTS

June 9, 2017, Toronto, Ontario: The APGO Education Foundation ("the Foundation") is pleased to announce the recipients of its annual awards under the Scholarship Program to support post-secondary students in the third year of a geoscience degree program at an Ontario university. The 2017 scholarship recipients are:

The Foundation scholarships are \$5,000 each. These students are on track to meet the requirements for advancement into a fourth year that will enable completion of the knowledge requirements for professional registration in the Association of Professional Geoscientists of Ontario (APGO). The scholarship recipients were chosen by a Selection Committee formed by the Board of Directors of the Foundation and received the scholarships at the Annual Meeting of APGO held on June 8th in Toronto.

They have exceptional academic credentials, and have demonstrated professionalism. These scholarships will help support them as they work to complete their geoscience degree program.
