APGO EDUCATION FOUNDATION ANNUAL REPORT DOCUMENTS YEAR OF ACHIEVEMENT IN 2021

November 1, 2022, Toronto, Ontario: The APGO Education Foundation ("The Foundation or APGOEF") is pleased to announce the release of its annual report for 2021 which is available on our website at **2021 Annual Report.** Despite the continuing challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Foundation was able to achieve solid progress in a number of areas. Highlights are as follows:

- Record donations of \$343,053 including the establishment of an endowment fund by Dr. Bill Pearson
- Major upgrades completed on GeoscienceINFO.com with virtual field trips (VFTs) and Geotrails moved to ESRI ArcGIS[™] and StoryMaps[™]
- GeoscienceINFO website moved to WordPress™ platform providing greater functionality
- Released Geovideo on the detailed geological and environmental history of the Niagara Escarpment
- Carried out teachers' workshop at the Annual GAC-MAC Meeting in London, Ontario
- Launched major StoryMap of Arkona highlighting a key fossil area in southern Ontario
- Completed initial work on prototypes for Geotrails along the Bruce Trail in the Hamilton-Niagara Region
- Developed a new blog: Beneath Your Feet: A Geoscience Blog which was launched on January 11, 2022
- Provided a grant of \$3,200 to the Arkona Lions Museum and Information Centre to purchase a microscope and LED TV to display microfossils.

Dr. Bill Pearson, P.Geo., Chair commented: "2021 was another year of solid achievements despite the continuing challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic. The major upgrades to our web platform for GeoscienceINFO.com and moving all our Virtual Field Trips and Geotrails to ESRI ArcGIS™ and StoryMaps™ has given us a very strong base to build on going forward. The limited field work we were able to do allowed us to develop prototypes for our first Geotrails on the Bruce Trail which we will build and expand on in 2022." Dr. Pearson continued:
